Subject aim: The aim of the course is to examine the basic premise of the discourse of the Interior Architecture as a necessary basis for understanding contemporary (engineering and design) problems and tasks in the design of furniture and other interior elements made of wood.

The objective of the course is to examine the context in which the architecture of the interior space and design in the architectural context arise, through the representation of theoretical domains that deal with the conditions of formation of the above discourses. This gives the student an insight into the position of the discipline in the wider social context, as well as the character of the interdependence of different types of knowledge in general.

Subject outcome: The outcome of the course is the understanding of the basic principles of the discourse of Interior Architecture, its theoretical determinants, and the basis of the design methodology. By enriching the thought base, the possibilities for creative behavior are expanded in relation to the current problems of modern design of furniture and other elements of interior architecture. In this way the student forms the capacity of critical thinking about the practice of discourse, but also the ability to critically evaluate their own attitudes.
